Founded in 2018 as a separate Section-8 Company under the Indian Companies Act, 2013, it serves as an incubator associated with Assam Agricultural University (AAU) in Jorhat. NEATEHUB is the only Agri Technology Business Incubator (TBI) in the North East region of India and has been recognized as a Excellence" "Centre of the Department of Agriculture Cooperation Welfare **Farmers** (DAC8FW), Government of India.



The NEATEHUB partners with RKVY-RAFTAAR (Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana - Remunerative Approaches for Agriculture and Allied Sectors Rejuvenation) and has been supporting RKVY-RAFTAAR Agribusiness incubators (R-ABI) in Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, and Tripura. NEATEHUB collaborates with 36 institutions, including CSIR NEIST (Jorhat), NIDJ, IIT-GBP, KIIT - TBI (Odisha), MANAGE (Telangana), and ICRISAT (Telangana). 




NEATEHUB team visits NEC
