

From the Desk of Director





NEATEHUB has created a dynamic startup ecosystem in the Northeast, nurturing innovations in areas such as farm mechanization, precision farming, food processing, supply chain management, and waste-to-wealth initiatives. The center has actively facilitated collaboration among diverse stakeholders, including government, research institutions, banks, and financial organizations.

This issue highlights the success of several startups graduating from NEATEHUB, showcasing their innovative solutions. Furthermore, the center actively engages in outreach activities to inspire and empower the younger generation to pursue a career in agriculture, a path often overlooked.



The AAU Incubator (North East Agriculture Technology Entrepreneurs Hub – NEATEHUB) is a unique Agri Technology Business Incubator of Assam Agricultural University headquartered in AAU, Jorhat. It was established as a separate Section-8 Company under the Indian Companies Act 2013 in 2018. Since its inception, the incubator has facilitated agri entrepreneurs of the Northeast Region across different stages of their entrepreneurial journey. The AAU Incubator is funded by NITI Aayog, Government of India, and it is also recognised as a Centre of Excellence by the Dept. of Agri Cooperation and Farmers Welfare (DAC&FW) for promoting its flagship funding scheme (RKVY-RAFTAAR – Remunerative Approaches for Agriculture and Allied Sectors Rejuvenation).

The Incubator's focus on the Agri and Allied Agriculture sectors and its promotion of emerging technologies offer unique opportunities for entrepreneurs in the region. NEATEHUB also has the establishment of three more incubators in NER – one each in Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram and Tripura. The core sectors pursued by startups and entrepreneurs at NEATEHUB include agritech, horticulture, livestock, fisheries, food processing, soil conditioning, natural fibre, textile, medicinal and aromatic plants, small farm machinery, etc. NEATEHUB also provides specialized preincubation training, capacity building on company operations, accounting, and legal services for the startups. High-quality personalized mentoring and coaching for business growth are given to budding entrepreneurs. NEATEHUB offers physical co-working space for startups and entrepreneurs. It also brings in industry linkages and networking, training and business coaching, technology transfer and IP portfolio management, legal and quality assurance services, seed funding and access to investment. As of March 2024, AAU Incubator has facilitated over 190 entrepreneurs, funded 42 agri startups and provided grant-in-aid support of approximately 4.5 crores.


be awarded to the top three positions, with special recognition for student ideas, women in technology, and innovative concepts from homemakers.

focus on mentoring, networking, capacity building, and advisory support in agriculture.

Looking ahead, this collaboration between NEATEHUB and SBI holds immense potential. SBI's role in disseminating information on general banking, credit counselling, and financial literacy to agri entrepreneurs will be instrumental in their growth. This MoU is a solid foundation for further collaboration between NEATEHUB and SBI on related activities, promising a bright future for agribusiness.




SARANYA Program SARANYA is a seed-stage incubation program helping agri-startups transition from prototype to minimum viable product.


FOUNDER OF THE STARTUP NUTRIXERIC WINS ENTREPRENEUR INNOVATION CHALLENGE
